Theme: "Faith in Action: The Life and Legacy of Pier Giorgio Frassati"

Let your artwork reflect the values and spirit of Pier Giorgio Frassati—his enthusiasm for charity, his love for the poor, his devotion to the Eucharist, his passion for the outdoors

Competition Categories:

- **Children (Ages 3-10) – Colouring Competition**

- **Youth (Ages 11-18) – Drawing Competition**
- **Open Category (All Ages) – Logo Design Competition**

Submission Deadline: 23 May 2025
Winners Announced: 7 June 2025

How to Enter:

Create an original artwork based on the competition category you are entering.

1. Each participant may submit only 1 entry.
2. Use any medium of your choice (crayons, pencils, watercolor, digital art, etc.).
3. For the youth category, artwork size must not exceed A3 (297 mm x 420 mm).
4. For the open category, the logo size must not exceed 50 mm x 50 mm.
5. Submit your entry by post to Ozanam Centre (Rm 119, G/F Blk 19, Shek Kip Mei Estate, Kowloon, Hong Kong); or in-person to a SSVP member or SSVP Nursery School.
6. When you submit your entry, please include the following information:
 - Your name, age and entry category
 - A short description (max 100 words) of how your artwork represents Pier Giorgio Frassati.

Prizes:

Winners in each category will receive special prizes!
The winning design in the Open Category may be used for commemorative gifts.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All submitted artwork must be original. Participants must ensure that their work has not been previously published in any form, used for any other purpose, or entered into any other competition.

Any elements used in the artwork must be legally acquired and permitted for publication, reproduction, and printing. Participants are solely responsible for any intellectual property rights associated with their work.

Once submitted, entries cannot be modified, exchanged, or returned to the participant.

By entering the competition, participants grant the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul (the Society) full copyright of the winning entries. The Society reserves the right to use, reproduce, publish, distribute, and modify the winning artwork in any format, without limitation in terms of frequency, location, or duration, and without additional compensation.

All judging decisions made by the Society are final.

The Society reserves the right not to select a winner if no suitable entries are received.

The Society retains the final decision-making authority over all aspects of the competition, including interpretation, modification, cancellation, or suspension of the rules, prizes, and other arrangements, without prior notice.

By submitting an entry, participants agree to abide by these terms and conditions. The Society reserves the right to disqualify any participant who violates these rules, and no appeals will be entertained.
